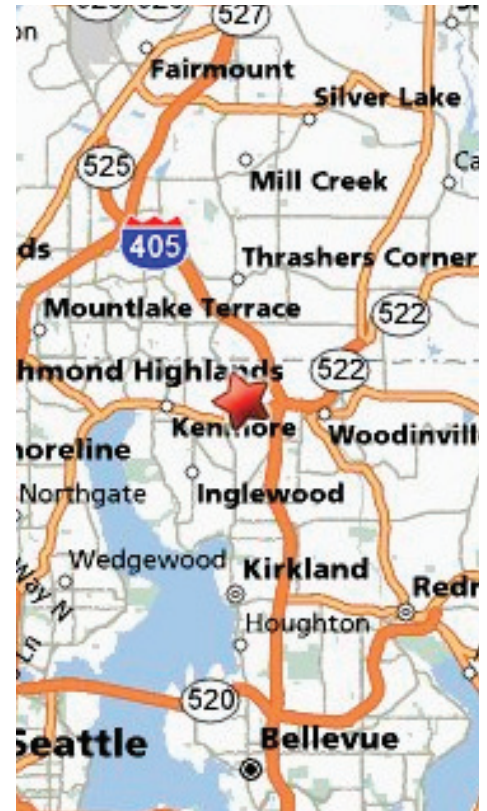

Bothell

Bothell was incorporated nearly 100-years ago (April 1909) as a frontier logging town filled with the spirit of innovation. As the region was populated, Bothell developed as a primary agricultural area in the production of dairy products. After the war era, Bothell emerged as a suburb to Seattle. Through the 1980's and 1990's, growth pressures pushed farms north, as sizeable corporate campuses with millions of square feet in commercial office and manufacturing space replaced them. Bothell is now widely known as a place of opportunity and the sweet spot in the High Tech/ Bio Tech Corridor, which spans from Redmond to Lynnwood.

Today, with its large, critical and innovative knowledge-work force, its new and expanding world-class university campus, and status as a hub for three public transit agencies, Bothell has become a strategic setting to accommodate the region's explosive growth.
