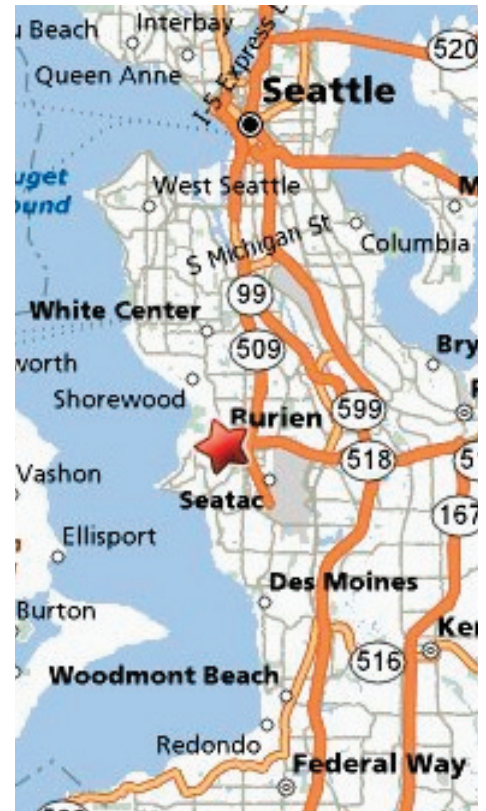

Since incorporation in 1993, Burien, a 100-year-old community with a rich heritage, has been busy defining and redesigning itself as a vibrant King County city. Burien's downtown area is currently undergoing several renovations which, when completed in 2009 will make Burien one of the regions premier new cities. In addition, a new towncenter is under construction that will include a new Burien Library, 70,000 square feet of retail space, and more than 400 condominiums with a plaza/park area in the middle and a parking garage below.
