Carnation

As a town, Carnation sprouts up from the broad Snoqualmie River Valley. The Old-fashioned storefronts on Tolt Avenue (state Route 203) are ringed by forested hills, and the snowy peaks of the Cascades that seemingly protect it against the outside.

The town, named for a dairy and started by white settlers who came to farm is being rediscovered as a bedroom town, a quiet locale with low crime and streets safe enough to raise a family.

Within the Snoqualmie Valley you will find a golf course, the nearby ski resorts of Snoqualmie and Stevens Passes, and horseback riding opportunities on such trails as the Tolt Hill Pipeline. The ever-popular Remlinger Farms is located here, open for fresh fruit and produce, and hosting events throughout the year.
