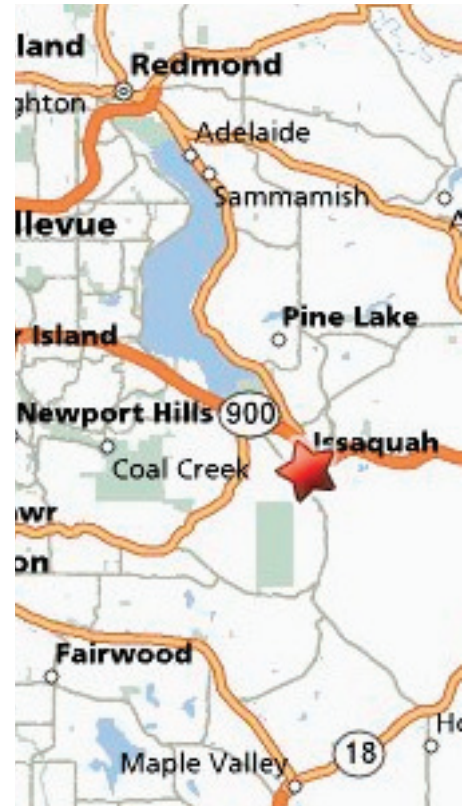

Issaquah

At the foot of the “Issaquah Alps,” Issaquah (ISS-a-kwa, pop. 13,000) offers an escape to country-fresh air in a fast-growing town loaded with history. Just two exits east of Sammamish on I-90, Issaquah’s hills are within a half-hour drive of Seattle and Tacoma. These are very old, worn-down mountains; their lower elevation keeps them mostly snow-free and hikeable virtually year-round. The town itself is a pleasant place to enjoy the blend of old and new; but get here soon, because gross condos, shopping malls, and suburbs are quickly devouring the remaining open space.
