

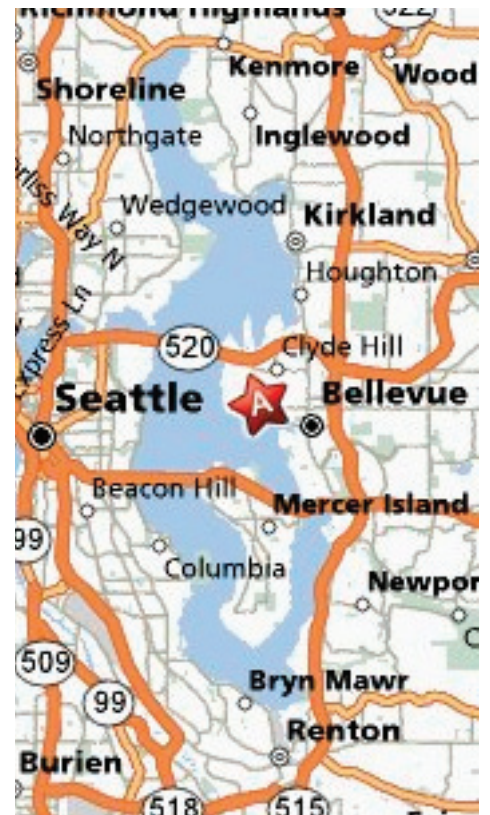

Medina

Medina is located in the Eastside, and is surrounded on the north, west, and south by Lake Washington, opposite Seattle. It is bordered by Clyde Hill and Hunts Point, as well as the satellite city of Bellevue.

Named in 1891 after the holy city of Medina in Saudi Arabia (yet pronounced differently, with a long "i"), Medina was platted in 1914 and officially incorporated on August 19, 1955.

Medina is connected to Seattle on the western shore of Lake Washington by Washington State Route 520 on the Evergreen Point Floating Bridge, the longest floating bridge in the world.
