North Bend

The City of North Bend was originally platted as “Snoqualmie” in 1889. The community later became known as Mountain View and finally, due to the location near the bend toward the North of the South Fork River, became the Town of “North Bend”. The City incorporated on March 12, 1909.

The town was made famous by David Lynch’s television series *Twin Peaks* (also filmed in nearby Snoqualmie.) Since the Weyerhaeuser sawmill closed, North Bend has become an upscale bedroom community for the Eastside of Seattle, Washington, with property values more than doubling from 1997 to 2006. The population was 4,746 at the 2000 census. David Lynch’s series *Twin Peaks* was filmed in North Bend and in the neighboring town of Snoqualmie, Washington.

Based on per capita income, one of the more reliable measures of affluence, North Bend ranks 52nd of 522 areas in the state of Washington to be ranked.
