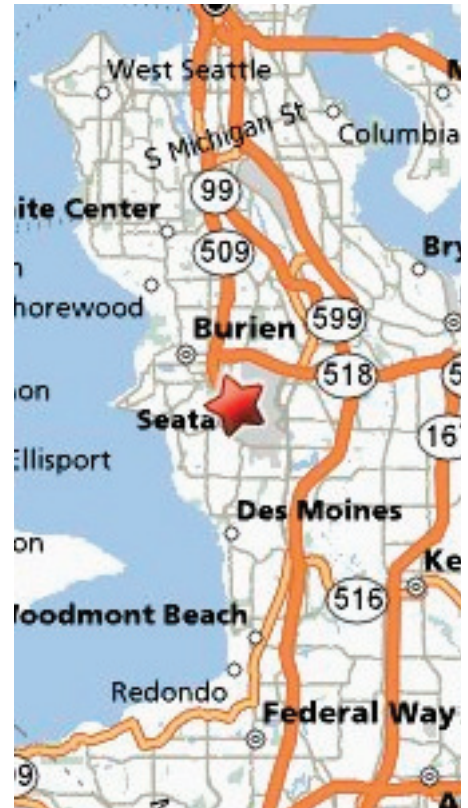


City of...

Incorporated in February 1990, the City of SeaTac is approximately midway between the cities of Seattle and Tacoma. The City is 10 square miles in area and has a population of 25,230.
