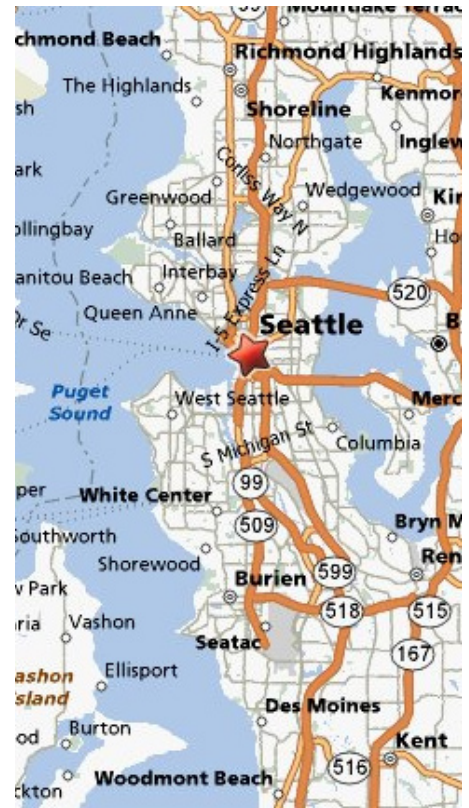
Seattle
