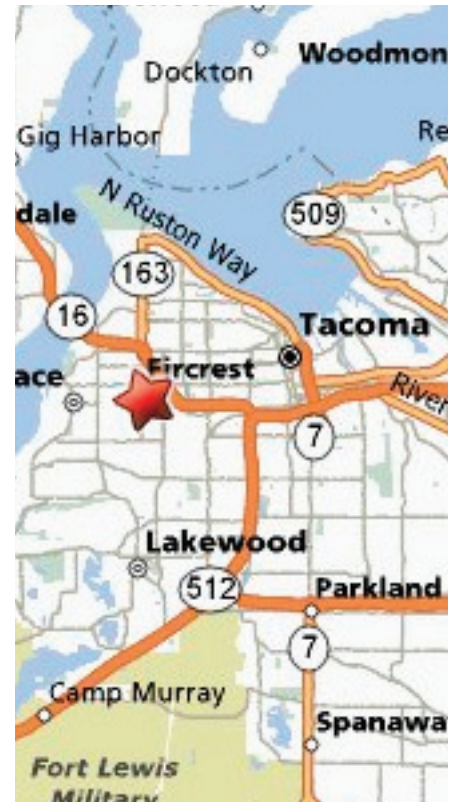

Fircrest

Fircrest was officially incorporated on September 19, 1925. Like its neighbor University Place, it is a wealthy suburb of Tacoma. The community was developed by Edward Bowes, who later gained fame as the host of the Major Bowes Amateur Hour radio talent show.

In 2000, Fircrest had a median family income of \$61,611. The city has a large middle class. The city benefits from its educated workforce. Home offices are common in Fircrest. The city, compared to most cities like it, can boast of a large population of high-income unmarried people.
