

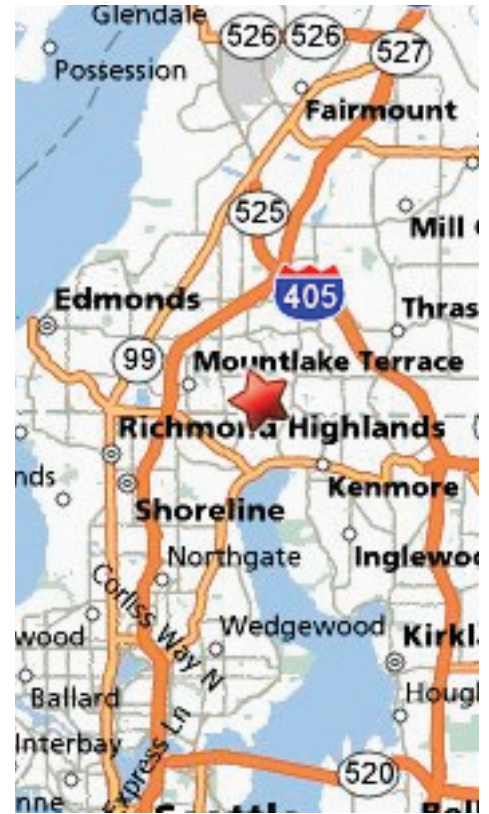

Brier

Brier is a small, suburban, residential town located about 15 miles north of the City of Seattle. The population is approximately 6,500.

The philosophy of the City is to continue to retain and maintain the basic, original, spacious and semi-rural wooded character of the areas and to remain relatively small, simple and intimate, with a minimum of regulation and taxation. It is intended that future development of Brier will be consistent and harmonious with the established pattern.

One of the more well-known events in Brier is SeaScare, a play on Seattle's much better known Seafair. It takes place in August and is a one-day affair, with a Porch Light Parade, contests, music and a screening of a classic movie, among other things. It involves nautical themes, in keeping with its Seafair ties. It is supported by the small number of Brier businesses. Seascare strives for a small town and community feel, explaining the nostalgic events and movie.
