# Gold Bar

Gold Bar started as a prospector's camp in 1889, named by a miner who found traces of gold on a river gravel bar. Gold Bar became a construction camp for the Great Northern Railroad. Gold Bar was officially incorporated on September 16, 1910. The 1940 population was 307. As of the census GR2 of 2000, there were 2014 people, 705 households, and 525 families residing in the city.
