There are currently four schools in the city of Granite Falls; two elementary, one middle school and one high school. A new high school will be built by Winter 2007.

Granite Falls started as an area by Native American fishing grounds. It then became a railroad station on the route between Monte Cristo (now a ghost town) and Everett. It slowly grew even though Monte Cristo didn't and was officially incorporated on December 21, 1903.
