Mill Creek

Mill Creek is a growing community located just east of Lynnwood along the I-5 corridor in Snohomish County. It is home to a diverse population of 17,620. The City of Mill Creek has gone through significant changes since incorporation in 1983. The City has doubled in area as annexations have occurred. Since incorporation, 14 annexations ranging between 2 and 300 acres in size have been approved by the City. As of February 2001, the City had a total area of 2,365 acres.

The majority of the developable land within the City of Mill Creek has now been developed or is under construction. All of the sectors in the original Mill Creek Master Plan have been developed. The Mill Creek Town Center is under construction and the majority of the SR 527 Corridor Sub-area has been developed with multifamily residential neighborhoods. SR 527 has been widened to five lanes between 164th Street SE and SR 96. This development activity implements the City's Land Use Plan to create a vibrant, livable community, where residents can live, work and play.
